

Voluntary In-Use Emissions Test of Your 2019 Ford F-650/F-750 6.7L Power Stroke™ Turbo Diesel

What is this program about, and why am I being contacted?

- Ford is conducting testing of customer-owned and operated, in-use vehicles as part of a
 U.S. Environmental Protection Agency requirement.
- The program was developed as a way to measure diesel exhaust on the road rather than in the laboratory.
- Our records indicate that your vehicle may meet the criteria for the test program.

How are the results of testing used?

- There is no obligation or consequence to you. You will not be held accountable for the emissions performance or condition of the engine in any way by participating in this program. The results of this program are meant only to monitor the emissions performance of the engine in your vehicle.
- All personal information relating to you, your company or business, your truck, or its vocation or use will be strictly confidential and will only be shared with those companies carrying out this testing and only for that purpose.
- All emission levels and data will be strictly confidential and will only be shared with the U.S. EPA or as required by law.





TEST INSTALLATION

The emissions test equipment includes analyzers, a temporary exhaust pipe, a small generator and a laptop computer connected to your vehicle's on-board diagnostics port.

What are the terms or conditions of the test?

- Participation is strictly voluntary. You will operate your truck as you would everyday.
- You agree to allow our engineers to install a specialized analyzer and equipment, conduct the test and then remove the equipment. The installation and removal will not affect your workday. Your truck will not be permanently altered in any way.
- If you elect to participate and your truck meets the screening criteria and is tested, you will receive \$500.00 and a \$100 fuel card.
